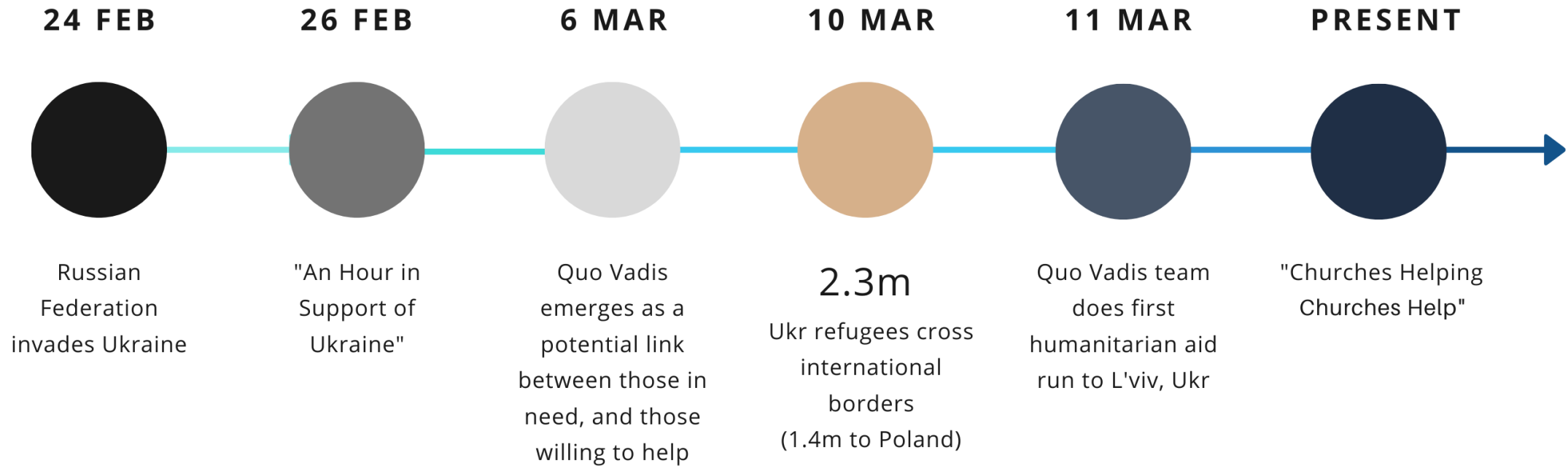

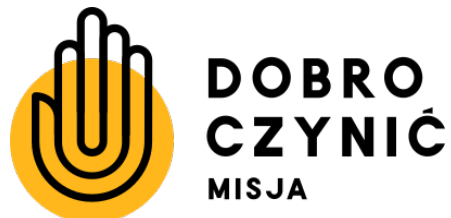


Who are we?

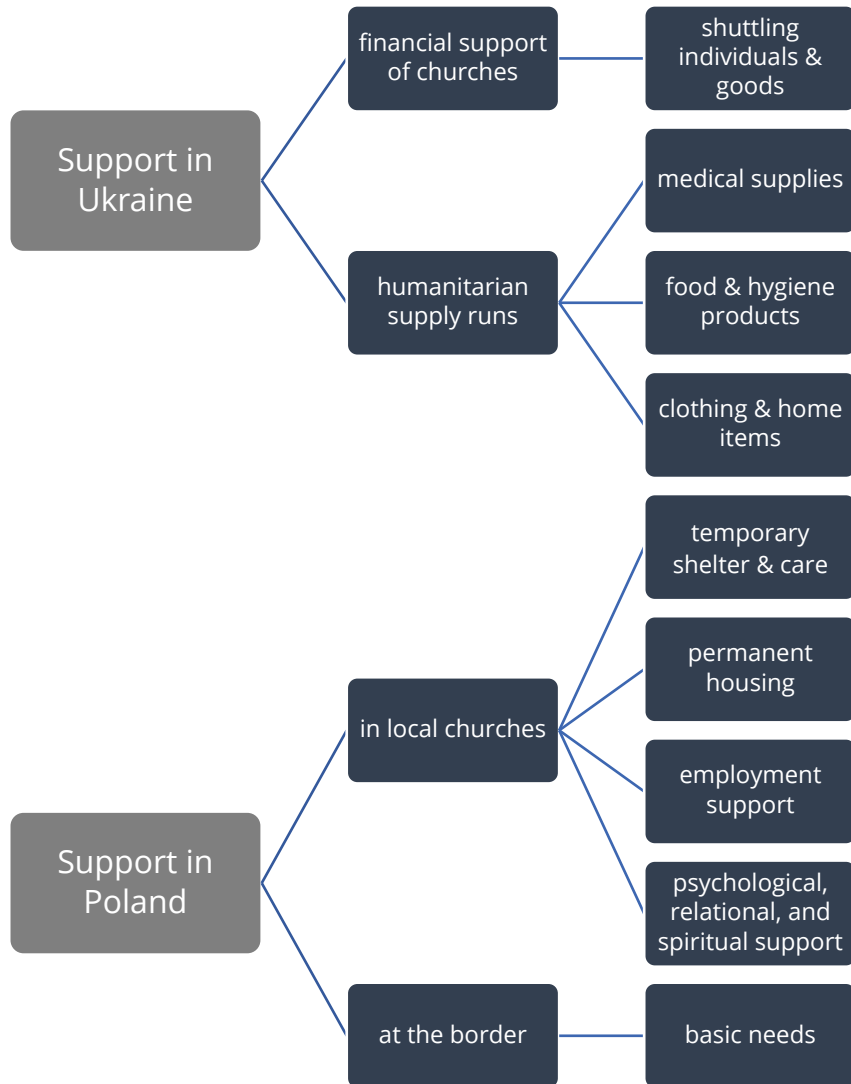


The Quo Vadis Institute is a European non-profit whose mission it is to inspire and connect thought leaders to rethink and shape the future of Europe.

Dobro Czynić ("Doing Good") is one of the few Polish church organizations with a unique tax status: members and supporters of the Church can donate 1% of their income tax to the charity work of Christian communities.

Strategy & Costs

Aid to Ukraine
4 vans a week
(for 10 weeks)
= 200,000 USD

Refugees in Poland
(for 3 months)
(+ 10% contingency)
= 200,000 USD

Financial assistance
(border aid,
Ukr churches)
= 100,000 USD

This project is **scalable**,
enjoys **local ownership, expertise**, and **credibility**,
supports **organic, bottom-up initiatives**,
is executed by **volunteers** (no staff costs),
and is connected to **reputational partners** in the USA
(such as National Christian Foundation, TrustBridge).
